# Funding for students and young scientists

The congress organisers have set aside a number of discretionary grants of €200 (£165GBP) to help a limited number of students and young scientists whose abstracts have been selected for oral presentation to offset the cost of attending the congress.

The criteria for selection are follows:

- Applicants should be either students (masters to pre-doctorate) or young scientists (within 3 years of PhD qualification)
- Grants are awarded on the condition that an abstract is submitted to the congress (provision of the grant does not automatically determine acceptance of the abstract)
- A signed statement from the applicant's supervisor must accompany any application
